Hospitals handle a significant amount of medical equipment and surplus assets throughout the device's lifecycle. Managing the disposal of these assets, especially at the end of their useful life, is a critical process that involves not only logistics but also ensuring strict compliance with regulations like HIPAA(Health Insurance

Portability and Accountability Act). A failure to comply with these regulations, particularly around the protection of Patient Health Information (PHI), can result in severe penalties and reputational damage. Hospitals are tasked with choosing whether to manage the disposition of their medical assets in-house or partner with an experienced asset management company.
