STATE BUDGET



Department of Health and Human Services

• Fully fund the SCDHHS/Medicaid budget request to support maintenance of effort, behavioral health initiatives, and enhanced funding for graduate medical education

Workforce Funding



- Continued funding for the Commission on Higher Education Nursing Initiative and the SC WINS scholarship program
- Funding for tuition mitigation, pilot programs, and educational opportunities for allied health professionals



Law & Order Proviso

• Funding for workplace safety enhancement grants to protect patients & employees

DMH Alternative Transportation (\$4.5M) & Patient Bed Capacity Funding (\$12.4M)

Lawsuit Reform

 Advocating for revisions to the definition of an Occurrence and clarity around damages and Gross Negligence claims against our member hospitals



340 B Program

• Protect access to the 340B program for SC hospitals and vulnerable patient populations



Itemized Billing

• Support consumer transparency with electronic itemized bills or, if requested, hard copies



Surgical Technologist Certification

- Identify grace period for certification for new hires that are either recent graduates or have been previously employed in another state.
- Include alternative pathway(s) for certification
- State agency approval for other/internal certification programs



Workplace Safety / Law & Order

- Inclusion of healthcare facilities as educational campuses with enhanced penalties for carrying firearms
- Preserve the right for hospitals to pursue assault charges on behalf of employees

OTHER LEGISLATION SCHA WILL SUPPORT / ENGAGE



- 1. Anesthesiologist Assistants ratio (support an increase from 1:2 to 1:4)
- 2. Other Scope of Practice Efforts (APRNs, PAs, etc)
- 3. Interstate Medical Licensure Compact
- 4. Alternative Transportation Legislation requested by DMH
